

# Approvals



It is a requirement to have any swim spa over 2000 litres approved.

It is the customers responsibility to arrange approvals. Splashes can assist if required.

In most cases a swim spa can be approved on a Complying Development Certificate (CDC).



In some case where the swim spa does not comply due to restrictions particular to your property, a Development Application (DA) may be required.

The swim spa must have a child safety approved lockable

cover (standard with all Splashes swim spas) otherwise fencing will be required.

In most cases the swim spa must fall into the building line, usually 1m from you boundary.

If there is storm water or sewage line nearby there could be a water board peg out required.

Upon purchase of your swim spa- Splashes will put you in touch with the relevant experts to get your approvals as quickly as possible.
